### **Chaplain to the Archbishop in Jerusalem**

*(Postholder required to source their own funding)*

- 3-year post; start date negotiable. The current Chaplain leaves in May 2018.
  - Postholder will be an ordained Anglican priest who is able and willing to work under the canons of the Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem.\*
  - Duties involve assisting the Archbishop in his national and international responsibilities, the Diocesan institutions and the running of his office. The post also entails working closely with the Dean of the Cathedral Church of St George the Martyr and includes responsibilities relating to the Cathedral congregation.

### **Chaplain to St George's College, Jerusalem**

*(Voluntary position)*

- Appointment is ideally for a period of 1 year but shorter terms are possible.

- Main areas of responsibility are liturgical leadership and the provision of theological reflections during College courses, and pastoral care for course members and College staff.
- Member of the Cathedral's ministry team so the postholder needs to be an ordained priest in the Anglican tradition, in good standing in the Anglican Communion, and willing and able to work under the canons of the Diocese of Jerusalem.\*
- Accommodation available for postholder and spouse; includes full board during College courses.
