



Lord, as the day begins lift up our hearts in praise; take from us all our sins, guard us in all our ways: our every step direct and guide that Christ in all be glorified!

Now as the day begins make it the best of days; take from us all our sins, guard us in all our ways: our every step direct and guide that Christ in all be glorified!




Change Principles

Kurt Lewin's Model of Change

Unfreezing, Changing, and Refreezing

Human change, whether at the individual or group level, is a profound psychological dynamic process that involves painful unlearning without loss of ego identity and difficult relearning as one cognitively attempts to restructure one's thoughts, perceptions, feelings, and attitudes.
